Days out in the sunshine!

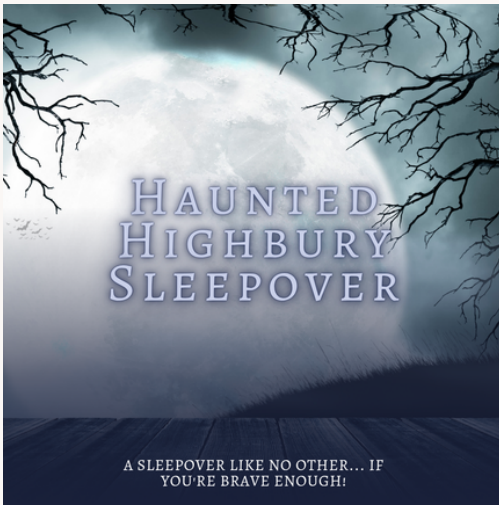

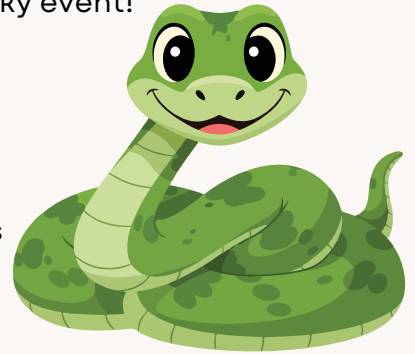


New fundraising events
